SYNOPSIS

In the suburbs of Long Island, Sherman – a black woman in her late 30s, finds herself responsible for her neighbor's son Osman, a 7 year old Syrian refugee Muslim boy's parents dies in an accident with no relatives to care for him. While struggling through her own grief over the loss of her unborn child, Sherman has to care for Osman. With cultural and linguistic barriers, how far will she go to make Osman feel at home? Sherman is a story of how learning to care for others can mobilize us beyond our own pain, empowering us to find a deeper strength to love and heal ourselves.
